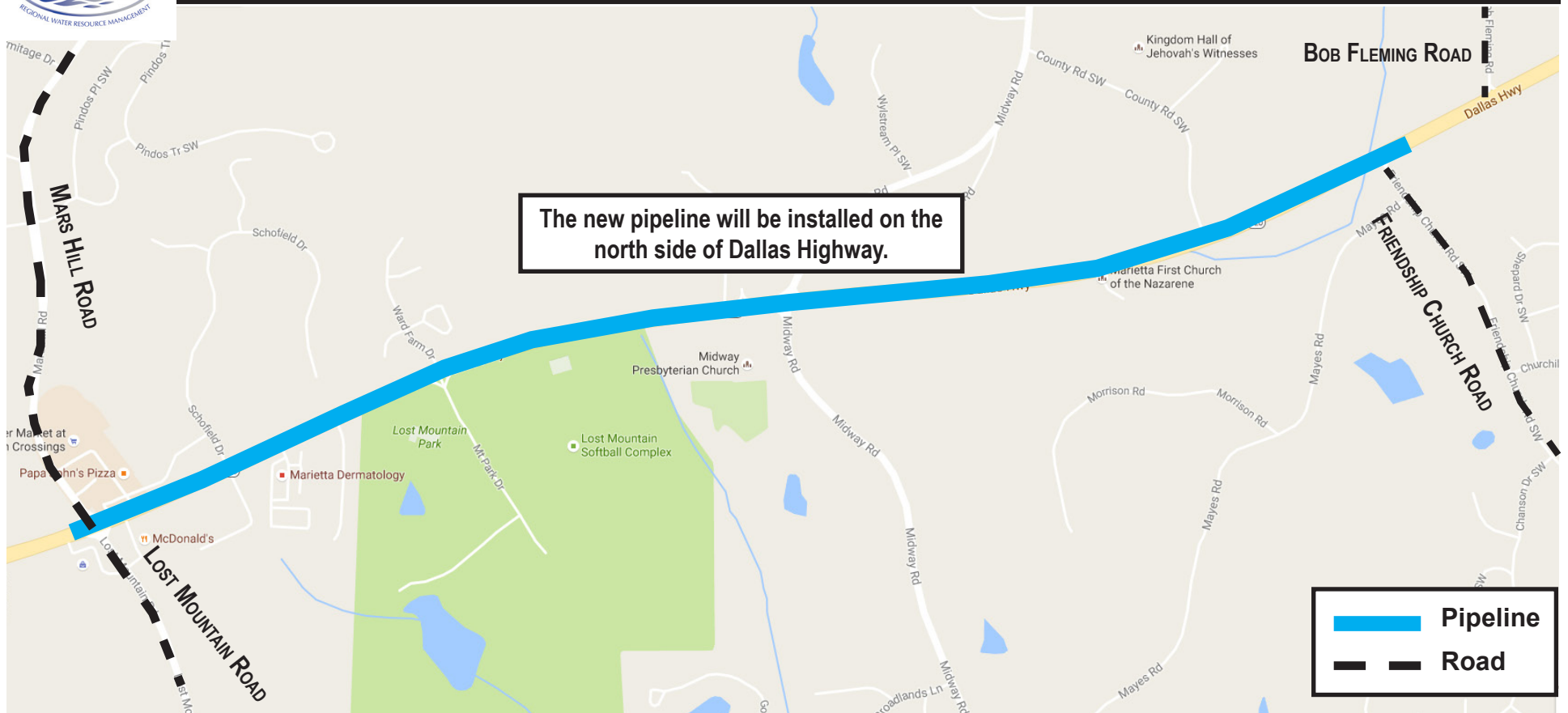




Dallas Highway Parallel Pipeline



The Dallas Highway Parallel pipeline project is an upgrade to the Authority's transmission system. Construction will be completed in 2017. A 36-inch ductile-iron water main will be constructed parallel to an existing 24-inch water main on Dallas Highway. The new water main will begin near Friendship Church Road. Construction will move west and end at the Authority's Lost Mountain water storage tanks. The parallel water line will increase water supply to the Authority's Lost Mountain water storage tanks and surrounding areas.

Will this project involve any road or lane closures?

CCMWA is permitted to close a single west-bound lane of Dallas Highway within the construction zone from 7am-3:30pm.
